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Biography

Earlier in his career, he represented plaintiffs in Federal Employers Liability Act, personal injury, occupational, and premises liability matters, handling all substantive written work, including dispositive motions, pleadings, and discovery.

Before law school, Mitch spent three years as an environmental scientist and consultant, researching energy and environmental regulations and representing clients before city, county, and state regulatory bodies — experience that informs a practical understanding of how regulatory frameworks intersect with business operations.
